Dr. Apparajoo Memorial Scholarship

The Penang Hindu Sabah has endowed a scholarship of \$3,000 collected from its own member as well as from the Indian community in general and from some well-wishers of Dr. R. Apparajoo, O.B.E., to perpetuate his name in the Penang Free School.

This scholarship is from the Indian community in recognition of Dr. Apparajoo's professional and community service before the war, during the period of the Japanese occupation, and subsequently.

The Scholarship is to be for boys of Indian parentage, to both sides, attending the Penang Free School and will be awarded annually to the most proficient and deserving poor boy on the result of the Standard VIII Examination.

Dr. Apparajoo Scholarships

The "Dr. Apparajoo Scholarship Fund Sub-Committee" of the Penang Hindu Sabah in a report just issued says that it has collected \$6,229.00 from the members of the Sabah as well as from the Indian community in general and from some well-wishers of Dr. R. Apparajoo, O.B.E.

The sub-committee consisted of the following:—President: Mr. K. V. AL. M. Arunasalam Chettiar, Hon. Secretary: Mr. K. Balram, Hon. Treasurer: Mr. R. Dorairaju, Committee Members: Messrs. S. Letchumanasamy, SN. SP. Muthalagoo Pillay, V. Suppliah, P. Velayutha Mudaliar, M. A. Subbiah and D. Baboo.

The report adds:—

IN THE PENANG FREE SCHOOL:

—Out of the Fund a sum of \$3000 has been vested in the Trustees of the Penang Free School to found a "Dr. Apparajoo Scholarship" in the said school. The Scholarship shall be confined to boys of Indian parentage on both sides attending the Penang Free School, and shall be awarded annually to the most proficient and deserving poor boy on the result of the Std. VII Examination. The Scholarship shall consist of the interest on the capital sum. An additional sum of \$75 has been sent to the P. F. S. Trustees to meet the award of the Scholarship for 1950.

OTHER SCHOLARSHIPS.—Ten other scholarships (each to the value of \$75/- per annum and tenable for 4 years) have been founded. These Scholarships shall be confined to boys of Indian parentage on both sides, attending Std VI, or above, and whose parents are in poor circumstances and whose conduct, industry, or school records have been satisfactory.

These Scholarships will be allotted in the following manner:—

- Anglo-Chinese School, Penang
2 Scholarships.
- St. Xavier's Institution, Penang
2 Scholarships.
- High School, Bukit Mertajam
3 Scholarships.
- St. Mark's School, Butterworth.
3 Scholarships.
