The report adds:-

IN THE PENANG FREE SCHOOL: -Out of the Fund a sum of \$3000 has been vested in the Trustees of the Penang Free School to found a "Dr. Apparajoo Scholarship" in the said school. The Scholarsh. shall be confined to boys of Indiai. parentage on both sides attending the Penang Free School, and shall be awarded annually to the mos proficient and deserving poor bo, on the result of the Std. VII. Examination. The Scholarship shall consist of the interest on the capital sum. An additional sum o: \$75 has been sent to the P. F. S. Trustees to meet the award of the Scholarship for 1950.

other scholarships (each to the value of \$75/- per annum and ten able for 4 years) have been founded. These Scholarships shall be confined to boys of Indian parentage on both sides, attending Sta VI, or above, and whose parents are in poor circumstances and whose conduct, industry, or school records have been satisfactory.
